What is the Difference Between a General Volunteer and Team Lead Volunteer?

- Team Lead Volunteers receive extra training in order to be the main point of contact when responding to a crisis event at a school. They are asked to be the liaison between the Tri-County School Response Team Coordinator and the School Building Contact during a crisis event. They are also in charge of ensuring volunteer teams have what they need to be successful.
- All Volunteers receive training in:
 - Tri-County School Response Team Volunteer Training
 - Question. Persuade. Refer. (QPR)
 - CONNECT Postvention Training
- Team Leads receive extra training in:
 - Tri-County School Response Team Lead Volunteer Training
 - Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training
