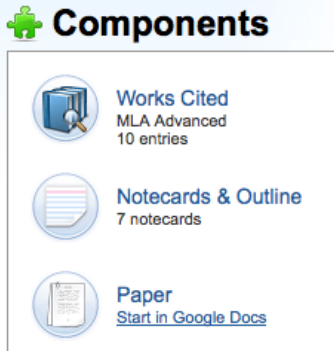
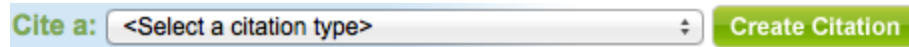


Printing Works Cited from Noodletools

1. Login to Noodletools
2. Open the project you are working on
3. In the “Components” box on your Dashboard click on “Works Cited”



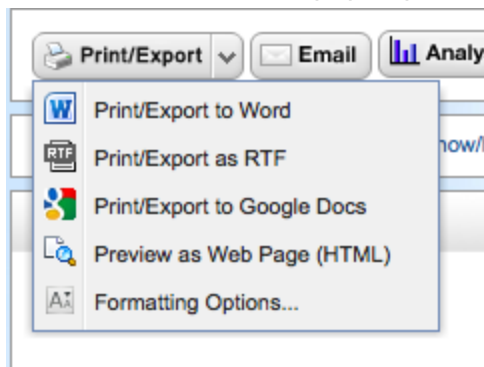
4. Right under




- locate and click on



5. From the menu that pops up, select the last option “Formatting Options”

Option	Current Setting (click to edit)
List Title:	Works Cited
Page Header:	Overcash (followed by one space and the page number)
Italics/Underlining:	Italics
Annotation Spacing:	Annotation starts on a new line
Include:	Citations only (no annotations)
URLs:	URLs are included in exported Works Cited

For each of 6 settings, click on the blue link to set your preference

List title: You have many options, but the two most common are

Works Cited--use this when you are only printing the citation information for the sources.

Annotated List of Works Cited--use this when you are including citations and annotations

Page Header: Enter your last name. Make sure you spell correctly and capitalize

Italics/Underlining: Select "Italics"

Annotation Spacing: This is a matter of your instructor's preference. For this assignment use "Annotation starts on a new line"

Include: Your options are "Print citations only" or "Print citations and annotations. Again, select which ever your instructor requires. For this assignment, please select "Print citations and annotations."

URLs: MLA 7th edition does not require you to include URLs, but some instructors want you to, so find out what is required for your assignment. For this assignment, select "Omit URLs from exported Works Cited"

7. Right under the "Formatting Options" menu, click on "Export As Word Doc."

- Download and/or open the document.
- Save the document
- Change the page number in the header to whatever you need it to be (if the last page of your paper is page 3, then the page number on the Works Cited page should be 4)
