SRO/SRD Contact Procedures –

IN AN EMERGENCY DIAL – 911

During SRO/SRD duty hours contact your SRO/SRD via their office phone, work cell phone, or work email.

If your SRO/SRD is on their off-duty day or at another school and you need law enforcement assistance (non-emergency) you can contact the SRO that is helping to cover down for your schools (see SRO assignments above).

If an SRO/SRD is not available, and you need law enforcement assistance for a non-emergency situation, you can contact the **Deschutes County Non-Emergency Call Center at: (541) 693-6911** to request a patrol officer.

If it is after 5 PM and you need law enforcement support contact the **Deschutes County Non-Emergency Call Center at: (541) 693-6911** to request help from a patrol officer.

Patrol officers will contact the SRO/SRD team during off duty hours if there is a school/student related nexus.

Your SRO/SRD will communicate directly with their school administration teams to deconflict their daily schedules and upcoming events (training, court dates, other assigned law enforcement duties). If you have any issues with SRO schedules, contact Scott Bojanowski and he will coordinate with the SRO team members and supervisors.

SRO/SRD Assignments & Contact Procedures

Notify Scott Bojanowski and/or Julianne Repman of any after-hours law enforcement or safety related concerns with students, staff, or facilities.

If there is an issue that could rise to the level of public interest or would be something the Superintendent should be briefed on, please reach out directly to Julianne Repman – (541) 355-1010 (office) or (541) 788-6890 (cell) to notify her of those issues.

Please use the district's **(541) 355-8888** phone number to notify the Superintendent's office and district leadership of any emergencies occurring at your school or worksite. Please call this number and leave a voicemail as soon as it is safe to do so after an emergency incident occurs and again once the incident is "all clear."
