



BLS Summer School Pointing

Overview:

Summer School 2021-2022 will run Aug 1-19. Students will attend a **Location School** listed below. If a student is matriculating, the summer school will be based on the school they are pointed to for the 22-23 school year.

- Students attending a school next year on an ACR, and they have been invited to that school for summer school, parents will need to provide transportation.
- HS students will attend the Base Camp at the HS they are attending next school year.


