BINS WILL ARRIVE JUNE 3RD!

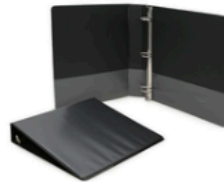
YOU WILL HAVE UNTIL "CHECK OUT" TO RECYCLE ITEMS



Schools will have labeled **curriculum recycling bins** for *each* of the following items:



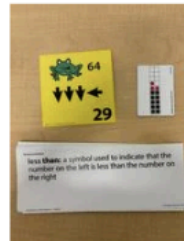
**Softbound

Binders**

Plastic**

EXAMPLES OF MOSTLY PLASTIC MATERIALS:

- pocket charts
- many number corner materials
- Some Work Place gameboards
- Most manipulatives
- ...

WHAT CAN/SHOULD YOU **KEEP**:

- **Bridges Intervention and Building Fact Fluency** will be used next year by Special Programs. Do not dispose of any of these materials.
- **Clear spinners** - the Amplify Desmos Spinners suggest “paper clips.” These spinners will be useful next year.
- Any **bins, bags, containers** you used for Bridges and Number Corner. Many of these can be reused.
- **Empty binders.** If you want to reuse these, you do not need to donate to FAN.
- You will receive a [manipulative kit](#) for *Amplify Desmos Math*, so don't feel like you need to keep the Bridges manipulatives. You may donate to students instead of recycling. Note: most Amplify manipulatives are made of foam.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DEFINITELY RECYCLE/DONATE/DISPOSE OF:

- Any Bridges & Number Corner PDFs, lessons, etc.
- Student Books
- Base Ten pieces
- Number Corner display and materials
