Inviting and Gathering Input from EAs for the IEP

Senate Bill 756 requires that classified staff are entitled to provide input and/or attend IEP meetings.

Helpful tips:

- Put the EA **working with the student on a goal area**, on the Team in Synergy
- Remind EAs to complete the input form that is sent out with all IEP calendar invites.
- Meetings do not need to be scheduled around EA schedule, but they can be timesheeted if they stay outside their hours
- EAs do not need to attend the whole IEP meeting, just the relevant parts where they can provide input.

Abbreviated School Day

As outlined in SB 819, all students in special education are entitled to a full day of school, per parent request.

Discipline

Please remember the 10-day rule for out-of-school suspension for students on an IEP. If you have a student who has been suspended multiple times, please reach out to your student services or student success coach - we'll help you create or update a PBSP.
